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# Deine Lakaien crochet doll set

Size: Approx. 14 cm

## Material:

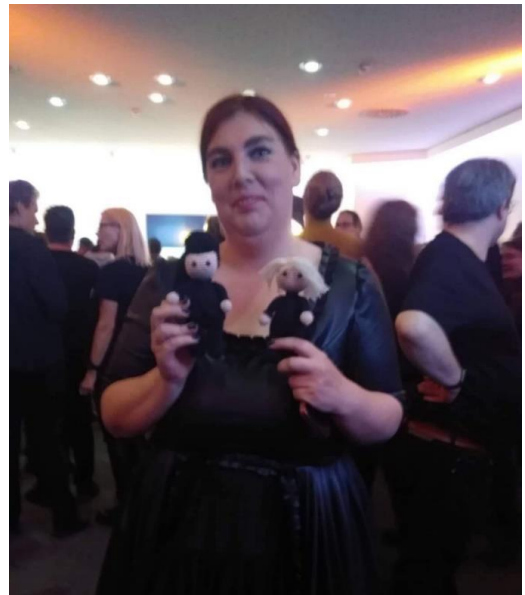
- Scheepjes Catona 110, Black (50g)  
Scheepjes Catona 255, Shell (25g)
- Scheepjes Metropolis 025 Nice (5g)  
Scheepjes Metropolis 080 Hamburg (10g)
- Safety Eyes 8mm (4), order 2 blue (Ernst) and 2 brown (Alexander)
- Doll eyeglasses 5cm (brand Scheepjes/Opry) or you can make them from metal wire.
- Stuffing
- Crochet hook 2.5 mm
- Scissor

## Crochet terms

Ch = chain

Sl st = slip stitch

Sc = single crochet

# Alexander Veljanov

## Alexander

You crochet the doll from bottom to top. So you start with the feet and end with the head in one piece. Later you add the arms and details of the coat.

### Legs

Start with Catona black (110) and magic loop.

Round 1: 6sc in magic loop = 6sc

Round 2: 2sc increase in every sc = 12sc

Round 3: \*1sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 18sc

Round 4: sc in every back loop = 18sc

Round 5: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 6: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x3 = 15sc

Round 7-15: sc in every sc = 15sc (9 rounds).

Stuff the leg.

Round 16: \*2sc, 2sc increase, 2sc\* x3 = 18sc

Fasten-off (only the first leg).

Make the second leg. Do not fasten-off the second leg!

Round 17: 5sc in first leg, go to the second leg (be shure that the toes are pointed to the same side, from now the front) 18 sc in second leg, continue in first leg 13sc = 36sc.

Round 18: \*5sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 42sc

Round 19-22: sc in every sc = 42sc (4 rounds)

Round 23: sc in every back loop = 42sc

Round 24: sc in every sc = 42sc

Round 25: \*5sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 36sc

Round 26-27: sc in every sc = 36sc (2 rounds)

Round 28: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x6 = 30 sc

Round 29-30: sc in every sc = 36sc (2 rounds)

Round 31: \*3sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 24sc

Round 32: sc in every sc = 24sc

Stuff the body.

Round 33: \*1sc, 2sc tog, 1sc\* x6 = 18 sc

Round 34: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 35: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12 sc

Round 36: sc in every back loop = 12sc

Schange colour to Shell (255)

Round 37: sc in every sc = 12sc

Round 38: 2sc increase in every front loop = 24sc

Stuff the body even more.

Round 39: \*3sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 30sc

Round 40: \*2sc, 2sc increase, 2sc\* x6 = 36sc

Round 41: \*5sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 42sc

Round 42: \*3sc, 2sc increase, 3sc\* x6 = 48sc





Round 43: \*7sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 54sc

Round 44-47: sc in every sc = 54sc (4 rounds)

Round 48: \*7sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 48sc

Place safety eyes on the front, between round 46 and 47, with a distance of 5 stiches.

Round 49: \*3sc, 2sc tog, 3sc\* x6 = 42sc

Round 50: \*5sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 36sc

Round 51: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x6 = 30sc

Round 52: \*3sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 24sc

Stuff the head.

Round 53: \*1sc, 2sc tog, 1sc\* x6 = 18sc

Round 54: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12sc

Round 55: 2sc tog x6 = 6sc

Fasten off.

## Coat

You crochet the typical Alexander coat by using the front loops of round 36 and 23.

### Collar

Start with black (Catona 110).

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch centre front of round 36 in front loop. Sc in every front loop (12sc), close with a slipstitch in first stitch.

Fasten off.

### Coat

Start with black (Catona 110).

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch centre front of round 23 in front loop. Sc in every front loop (41sc), turn, chain of 1.

Round 2: 2tog, 39sc turn chain of 1 = 40sc.

Round 3: 2tog, 38sc turn chain of 1 = 39sc.

Round 4: 2tog, 37sc turn chain of 1 = 38sc.

Fasten off.

Border slipstitch in slipstitch inf round 23. Sc in every stich of the jacket 3sc in corners.

Fasten off in first stitch



## Arms

Start with Catona Shell (255).

Round 1: 6sc in magic loop = 6sc

Round 2: 2sc increase in every sc = 12sc

Round 3: \*1sc, 2sc increase \* x6 = 18sc

Round 4: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 5: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12sc

Stuff hand.

Round 6: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x3 = 9sc

Change to Catona black (110)

Round 7: sc in every back loop = 9sc

Round 8-16: sc in every sc = 9sc (9 rounds)

Stuff arm.

Round 17: Rd: fold the arm flat and crochet true both layers.

SC in both layers = 4sc.

Fasten my off. Leave some yarn to sew the arm.

Start with Catona black (110) and magic loop.

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch in row 7. 9sc in front loop, close with a slipstitch.

Fasten off.

Sew the arms on the sides of the body on Rd 36.

## Hair

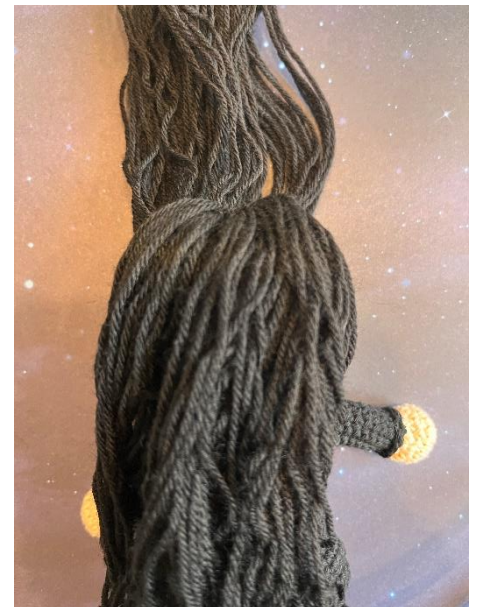
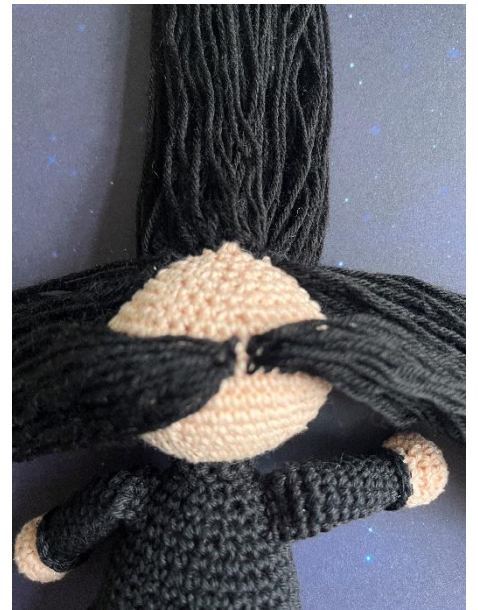
Use Scheepjes Metropolis 080 Hamburg to make the hair.

Wrap the yarn around an old bootleg and cut it on one side. The hair is to long but this way it's easy to tie it.

Tie the hair around the stitches by folding it in half. Take the ends through the loop.

- Start 4 rows above the eyes.
- Make the front line end around 5 stitches outside the eyes.
- Go down around 5 rows
- Fill it up by adding rows to the back. Make it a nice full look of hair.
- Split the hair in 3, one middle and the two sides. \*\*\* see picture\*\*
- Put the middle to the front and leave it.
- Tie the to sides together with a piece of yarn or elastic. You can also make a knot with the hair the make more height. \*\*\* see picture\*\*\*
- Put the middle piece of the hair over the knot and tie it to a ponytail.
- Fill up the back of the hair by embroider with black yarn under the tail to finish the look.

Cut the hair in length





# Ernst Horn



## Ernst

You crochet the doll from bottom to top. So you start with the feet and end with the head in one piece. Later you add the arms and details of the shirt.

### Legs

Start with Catona black (110) and magic loop.

Round 1: 6sc in magic loop = 6sc

Round 2: 2sc increase in every sc = 12sc

Round 3: \*1sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 18sc

Round 4: sc in every back loop = 18sc

Round 5: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 6: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x3 = 15sc

Round 7-15: sc in every sc = 15sc (9 rounds).

Stuff the leg.

Round 16: \*2sc, 2sc increase, 2sc\* x3 = 18sc

Fasten-off (only the first leg).

Make the second leg. Do not fasten-off the second leg!

Round 17: 5sc in first leg, go to the second leg (be sure that the toes are pointed to the same side, from now the front) 18 sc in second leg, continue in first leg 13sc = 36sc.

Round 18: \*5sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 42sc

Round 19-22: sc in every sc = 42sc (4 rounds)

Round 23: sc in every back loop = 42sc

Round 24: sc in every sc = 42sc

Round 25: \*5sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 36sc

Round 26-27: sc in every sc = 36sc (2 rounds)

Round 28: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x6 = 30 sc

Round 29-30: sc in every sc = 36sc (2 rounds)

Round 31: \*3sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 24sc

Round 32: sc in every sc = 24sc

Stuff the body.

Round 33: \*1sc, 2sc tog, 1sc\* x6 = 18 sc

Round 34: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 35: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12 sc

Round 36: sc in every back loop = 12sc

Change colour to Shell (255)

Round 37: sc in every sc = 12sc

Round 38: 2sc increase in every front loop = 24sc

Stuff the body even more.

Round 39: \*3sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 30sc

Round 40: \*2sc, 2sc increase, 2sc\* x6 = 36sc





Round 41: \*5sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 42sc  
 Round 42: \*3sc, 2sc increase, 3sc\* x6 = 48sc  
 Round 43: \*7sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 54sc  
 Round 44-47: sc in every sc = 54sc (4 rounds)  
 Round 48: \*7sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 48sc  
 Place safety eyes on the front, between round 46 and 47, with a distance of 5 stiches.  
 Round 49: \*3sc, 2sc tog, 3sc\* x6 = 42sc  
 Round 50: \*5sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 36sc  
 Round 51: \*2sc, 2sc tog, 2sc\* x6 = 30sc  
 Round 52: \*3sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 24sc  
 Stuff the head.  
 Round 53: \*1sc, 2sc tog, 1sc\* x6 = 18sc  
 Round 54: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12sc  
 Round 55: 2sc tog x6 = 6sc  
 Fasten off

## Shirt

You crochet the shirt of Ernst by using the front loops of round 36 and 23.

### Collar

Start with black (Catona 110).

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch centre front of round 36 in front loop. Sc in every front loop (12sc), close with a slipstitch in first stitch.

Fasten off.

### Belt

Start with black (Catona 110).

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch centre front of round 23 in front loop. Sc in every front loop (42sc), close with a slipstitch in first stitch.

Fasten off.



## Arms

Start with Catona Shell (255).

Round 1: 6sc in magic loop = 6sc

Round 2: 2sc increase in every sc = 12sc

Round 3: \*1sc, 2sc increase\* x6 = 18sc

Round 4: sc in every sc = 18sc

Round 5: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x6 = 12sc

Stuff hand.

Round 6: \*1sc, 2sc tog\* x3 = 9sc

Change to Catona black (110)

Round 7: sc in every back loop = 9sc

Round 8-16: sc in every sc = 9sc (9 rounds)

Stuff arm.

Round 17: Rd: fold the arm flat and crochet true both layers.

SC in both layers = 4sc.

Fasten my off. Leave some yarn to sew the arm.

Start with Catona black (110) and magic loop.

Round 1: Start with a slipstitch in row 7. 9sc in front loop, close with a slipstitch.

Fasten off.

Sew the arms on the sides of the body on Rd 36.

## Hair

Use Scheepjes Metropolis 025 Nice to make the hair. Wrap the yarn around an old bootleg and cut it on one side. The hair is to long but this way it's easier to tie it.

Tie the hair around the stitches by folding it in half. Takes the ends true the loop.

- Start 4 rows above the eyes.
- Make the front line end around 5 stitches outside the eyes.
- Fill it up to the back make around 3 rows.
- Make the centre part to the back just outside the middle (above the right eye)
- Fill it like you wish but not to thick.
- Cut the hair in wright length and shape. You can turn it in your favourite look of him.
